



YOUR UNITED WAY DOLLARS WORKING IN BROOKE COUNTY

- 220 persons received disaster assistance, health & safety training, service to military families, and or donated blood through the American Red Cross/Northwest West Virginia.
- Catholic Charities West Virginia helped 142 households with emergency rent and utilities.
- 31 girls were active in the Girl Scouts in Brooke County.
- 803 seniors participated in the Nutrition Program at Brooke County Committee on Aging.
- 23 seniors were provided with in-home services through Brooke County Committee on Aging.
- 106 seniors received transportation from the Brooke County Committee on Aging.
- 23 participated in the ABE (formerly G.E.D.) program at the Brooke County Library.
- 129 participated in education forums at the Brooke County Library.
- 612 children participated in special programs at the Brooke County Library.
- 2 seniors received Social Support Services and 9 individuals participated in the conservator program through Family Service of the Upper Ohio Valley.
- 252 residents received emergency assistance with utilities, rent and/or food from the Salvation Army, Brooke and Hancock Counties.
- 525 families received Christmas assistance through Salvation Army, Brooke and Hancock Counties.
- Wheeling Health Right served 137 patients from Brooke County.
- 2 young moms were mentored or received clothes/baby essentials from Gabriel Project of West Virginia.

- 7 individuals were clients and/or participants in educational programs provided by the Sexual Assault Help Center.
- 80 people participated in health and physical fitness programs including aquatics and team sports at the YMCA.
- 96 linkage and referrals were given by Information Helpline.
- 7 residents received emergency assistance from Information Helpline.
