



## YOUR UNITED WAY DOLLARS WORKING IN MARSHALL COUNTY

- 607 persons received disaster assistance, health & safety training, service to military families, and or/ donated blood through the American Red Cross/River Valley Chapter.
- Catholic Charities West Virginia helped 33 people with emergency rent and utilities.
- 435 families received food baskets from Catholic Charities West Virginia/Catholic Neighborhood Center.
- 228 girls were active in the Girl Scouts
- 223 residents participated in Family Service Upper Ohio Valley's nutrition program.
- 95 seniors received social support i.e. telephoning, visiting, etc. from Family Service/Upper Ohio Valley.
- 33 individuals benefited from Family Service Upper Ohio Valley's Conservator Program
- 224 individuals were served by Harmony House for forensic interviews.
- 2,016 people received assistance with emergency rent, food, utilities, etc. at the Salvation Army, Marshall, Wetzel & Tyler Counties.
- 440 individuals received Christmas Assistance from the Salvation Army, Marshall, Wetzel & Tyler Counties for Marshall County.
- 3 individuals participated in programs at WATCH.
- Wheeling Health Right served 4,763 patients from Marshall County.
- 303 individuals received help and support from the YWCA's Family Violence Prevention Program.
- 125 women received assistance at the "Y" Not Repeat Boutique at the YWCA.

- 24 young first-time mothers received mentoring from Gabriel Project of West Virginia.
- 118 individuals were served as clients or participants in educational programs provided by Sexual Assault Help Center.
- 340 residents participated in health and physical fitness programs including aquatics and team sports provided by the YMCA.
- 55 residents received assistance with emergency rent, food or utilities from Information Helpline.
- 15 individuals participate in programs at Russell Nesbitt Services.
- 4 residents are learning to read thanks to Literacy Volunteers of Marshall and Ohio Counties.
- 141 individuals were helped by Society of St. Vincent de Paul with rent, utilities and/or furniture.
