



YOUR UNITED WAY DOLLARS WORKING IN OHIO COUNTY

- 542 persons received disaster assistance, health & safety training, and service to military families through the American Red Cross Northwest West Virginia.
- CASA for Children, Inc. assisted 280 children that were in the foster care system.
- Catholic Charities West Virginia helped 211 people with emergency rent and utilities.
- 2,194 families received food baskets from Catholic Charities West Virginia/Catholic Neighborhood Center.
- 525 girls were active in the Girl Scouts.
- 367 residents participated in Family Service Upper Ohio Valley's nutrition program.
- 1,995 seniors received social support i.e. telephoning, visiting, etc. from Family Service Upper Ohio Valley.
- 243 seniors were provided with transportation provided by Family Service/Upper Ohio Valley.
- 16 people were served through the Adult Day Care provided by Family Service Upper Ohio Valley.
- 72 seniors used in-home services of Family Service Upper Ohio Valley.
- 603 seniors enjoyed wellness and recreation programs at Family Service/Upper Ohio Valley.
- 103 young moms were assisted with mentoring and clothing/baby essentials by Gabriel Project of West Virginia.
- Gabriel Project of WV had 73 residents attend abstinence education programs through schools and youth programs.

- 263 individuals were served by Harmony House for forensic interviews.
- There were 356 incidents of service of people receiving assistance with emergency rent, food, utilities, etc. at the Salvation Army of Wheeling.
- 536 individuals received Christmas Assistance from the Salvation Army, Wheeling.
- There were 12,432 people sheltered by the Salvation Army, Wheeling.
- 590 residents were helped with emergency assistance, i.e. utilities, from St. Vincent de Paul Society.
- Wheeling Health Right served 8,212 patients from Ohio County.
- 552 individuals were sheltered and received help and support from the YWCA's Family Violence Prevention Program.
- YWCA's Cultural Diversity and Community Outreach program reached 4,575 in your County.
- 761 individuals were served as clients **or** participants in educational programs provided by Sexual Assault Help Center.
- 5,360 residents participated in health and physical fitness programs including aquatics and team sports provided by the YMCA.
- 412 residents received assistance with emergency rent, food or utilities from Information Helpline Upper Ohio Valley.
- 249 families received Thanksgiving baskets through Information Helpline.
- 103 individuals participate in programs at Russell Nesbitt Services
- 4 residents are learning to read thanks to Literacy Volunteers of Marshall and Ohio Counties.
- 167 children attended Youth Service Systems, Inc. after care programming.
- 33 children were matched with mentors through Youth Service Systems, Inc.

- 103 children attended Holy Family Child Care Center.
- 27 people received assistance with low vision aids and technology demonstrations at Seeing Hand Association.
- 1,438 residents participated in educational presentations by Seeing Hand Association.
- 77 individuals participated in the Seeing Hand's workshop and vision screenings.
- 38 residents participated in the WATCH program, a division of Russell Nesbitt Services.
