



YOUR UNITED WAY DOLLARS WORKING IN WETZEL COUNTY

- 824 persons received disaster assistance, health & safety training, service to military families and/or donated blood through the American Red Cross.
- 116 smoke alarms were installed into individuals homes for free.
- 103 girls were active in Girl Scouts.
- 224 seniors participated in the nutrition program for seniors through Family Service Upper Ohio Valley.
- 13 residents were served through the Conservator Program of Family Service/Upper Ohio Valley.
- 6 individuals were served by Harmony House for forensic interviews.
- 40 individuals received assistance with emergency rent, food and/or utilities from the Salvation Army, Marshall, Wetzel & Tyler Counties.
- 132 people were assisted at Christmas time through the Salvation Army, Marshall, Wetzel & Tyler Counties in Wetzel County.
- Wheeling Health Right served 1,912 patients in Wetzel County.
- 50 individuals participated in health and physical fitness programs including aquatics and team sports provided by the YMCA.
- 294 residents received assistance from the YWCA's Family Violence Prevention Program.
- 32 individuals received assistance with linkage and referral from Information Helpline Upper Ohio Valley.
- 6 individuals participated in programs at Russell Nesbitt Services.
- 2 adults and 2 children were sheltered by the YWCA's Family Violence Prevention Program.
- 125 individuals received assistance with emergency rent, utilities and/or food from the Catholic Charities food pantry.

- 315 children received backpacks through Catholic Charities WV in your County.
- 333 individuals received Food Baskets from Catholic Charities West Virginia.
- 72 young moms were assisted with mentoring, clothing/baby essentials by Gabriel Project.
- 80 people were educated through Seeing Hand Association presentations about their services and Low Vision Aids/Technology demonstrations.
