**American Red Cross**

The Chapter's Home Fire Campaign which installs free smoke alarms in area homes as well as provide financial assistance to victims of house fires.

**CASA for Children, Inc.**

Prevention efforts to reduce the number of incidents of child abuse and neglect in our local communities.

**Gabriel Project**

This program purchases new car seats, cribs, and infant formula for local families that need assistance with such items.

**Holy Family Child Care & Development Center**

Using the funding to gain the necessary credentials and take courses that will help their accreditation and make them a Type III Center.

**Salvation Army – Belmont County**

Emergency Food Pantry Services; Emergency Assistance - utility, clothing, furniture vouchers; Emergency Medical Services; Emergency Shelter; Emergency Disaster Services.

**Salvation Army – Wheeling**

Provide a tiered program of housing and assistance in employment for their clients.

**Tri-County Help Center**

Provide printed materials for prevention awareness during community events and throughout the area.

**Youth Services System**

Childcare Programs, providing a safe place for children and preparing youth for school by providing tutorial and homework assistance. Youth Mentoring Network, creating relationships that provide powerful positive effects on young people. Expanded Mental Health Program in schools that provides a system of support.

**Brooke County Committee on Aging**

Meals for seniors are provided either at congregate sites for companionship, or in-home for those homebound. Meals are provided for a donation only, but no senior is denied service due to lack of ability to pay.

**Catholic Charities West Virginia**

Emergency assistance (addressing short-term, immediate financial support), case management (helping families address both their immediate and future well-being), and Hospitality House programs (an extension of the other services providing short-term, transitional housing and further case management).

**Girl Scouts**

Financial assistance for girls and adults; volunteer support. Costs include background checks for volunteers that otherwise could not afford to pay and fees for membership for those families that need assistance.

**Information Helpline**

Information and referral – for the 211 program to connect clients with support and services.

**Salvation Army – Brooke County**

Community Lunch Program, which provides well balanced meals and teaches proper nutrition. Family Service Program - helps keep families and individuals in place for at least 30 days.

**Seeing Hand Association**

Offer employment and learning opportunities for the blind or visually impaired.

**Wheeling Health Right**

Provide consumable supplies for the Dental Clinic as well as prosthodontic work, allowing for patients who could not otherwise afford dental care obtain better health and improved quality of life.

**YWCA**

The Family Violence Prevention Program (FVPP) works with families suffering abuse in their homes. By providing safe shelter, education about cycles of violence, court advocacy and other supportive services they work to ensure the end of the violence for these survivors.

**Brooke County Public Library**

Supports the many programs offered by the Library and those they partner with to offer education, training, outreach, and various communication activities.

**Family Service – UOV**

Support of In-Home Program which offers services within a senior's home so they may stay independent for as long as possible.

**Harmony House**

Support of prevention education with a focus on the prevention of abuse and neglect within the community as well as technology and social media dangers, human trafficking and the opioid epidemic's impact on children and families.

**Russell Nesbitt Services**

Providing transportation for doctor appointments, community outings, special extra-curricular trips, and travel to work or services provided by the agency.

**Salvation Army – Marshall, Wetzel, and Tyler Counties**

Programming to help those in the community who have fallen on hard times to pay their utility bills that are in danger of termination.

**Sexual Assault Help Center**

Ultimately provide Prevention Programming with the goal of increasing the quality and frequency of the free community self-defense classes now being offered as well as sustain their free services to victims of sexual violence.

**YMCA**

Support for the "Y" 4 Life Summer camp and mentoring program for kids in grades 6-8. This provides a safe day camp and mentoring for children at a free or reduced rate.
